



## Social Housing Frequently Asked Questions



### What can the Social Housing Department help me with?

The Social Housing department can help you obtain/maintain housing within Lanark County. We run a variety of programs that can help you. To find out more about a specific program please see the quick links bar and click to find out more. If you have questions about housing options please call and speak with one of our caseworkers, who may be able to help you

### What programs do you offer?

Lanark County Social Housing offers many programs including:

- Social Housing Registry for Rent Geared to Income (RGI) housing
- Homeownership
- Renovate Lanark
- Minor Home Repair
- Rent Support
- Housing Allowance
- Housing Options
- Domiciliary Hostels
- Homemakers

However, our programs are always changing based on funding available.

### Where Do I send applications?

In each quick link section there is a *contact us* column on the right hand side, that column will tell you who at Lanark County to contact regarding that specific program. ### **Who do I call if I need help?**

If you need help filling out an application, you can set up a meeting time with one of the caseworkers who will help you complete the application processes. You can contact the Social Housing Clerk at 613-267-4200 ext. 2402 who can answer your questions or put you in contact with the right caseworker.

### **How do I know if a program is still open or if there is a waitlist?**

The best way to find out if a program is still open, regardless of what is posted is to call the Social Housing Clerk at 613-267-4200 ext. 2402. Some programs have application deadlines (Example: Renovate Lanark) and some programs may have waitlists (example: Rent Support Program).
